Their eyes did not "see" Jesus for who he was, nor did their hearts respond to his mercy. They could not accept him as the healer, Saviour and Messiah that he said he was.

Truth is always challenging. The pride and self-righteousness of the people of Nazareth prevented them from understanding who Jesus was. Instead of accepting Jesus as their Lord and Saviour, they attempted to murder him by throwing him off a cliff.





**One gift, one Spirit: persevering in the service of Jesus` ministry.** As it was with the prophets before him, Jesus was not embraced with loving arms. He met resistance early on in his ministry. Speaking the truth and challenging the status quo is a risky thing. Paul speaks today of the spiritual gifts of faith, hope and love, with love as the superior gift. These gifts must have strengthened Jesus in his ministry. If we follow him, we should not be surprised if we encounter resistance. But faith, hope and, above all, love can sustain us.

**Homework:** a conversation with someone who has a different point of view than ours could be difficult – this week let us practice recognizing that all people are part of God’s family, sinners and saints, all people. This does not mean we have to agree with what they say, but it does mean that salvation is offered to them.
